As you may already know, Tuesday, 4 July 2023 is the date for the annual Monument Hill Kiwanis 4th of July Parade. As in previous years, the Old Denver Highway will be used as a staging area for the parade. One lane of traffic will be used to line up parade participants, while the other lane will be used for through traffic in both directions. If you need to travel on Old Denver Highway on the morning of the 4th between the hours of 6:00 am - 12:00 noon, please exercise caution for the safety of those lining up for the parade.

Old Denver Highway will not be closed and you will not be denied access to your residence at any time. However, to ease your access before and during the parade, you may use this letter as a Resident's Pass. It is for your convenience and to save your time. Please show this pass to parade officials if you need to travel along the parade route on the morning of the parade. This will enable parade organizers to allow you to pass freely in and out of neighborhoods and businesses. If you have guests who will be transiting Old Denver Highway during the time in question, you make a copy of this letter or go to <https://mhkiwanis.org> and click on Uncle Sam's Hat in the left panel to obtain a duplicate.
